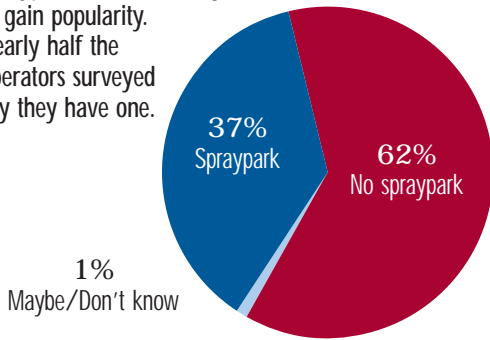
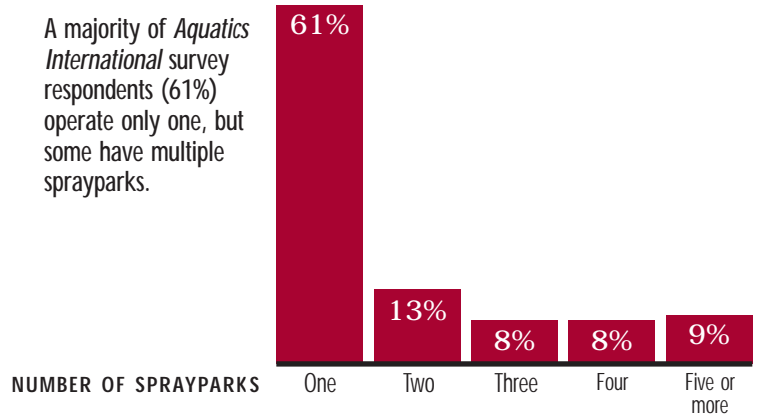


Sprayparks are continuing to gain popularity. Nearly half the operators surveyed say they have one.



A majority of *Aquatics International* survey respondents (61%) operate only one, but some have multiple sprayparks.

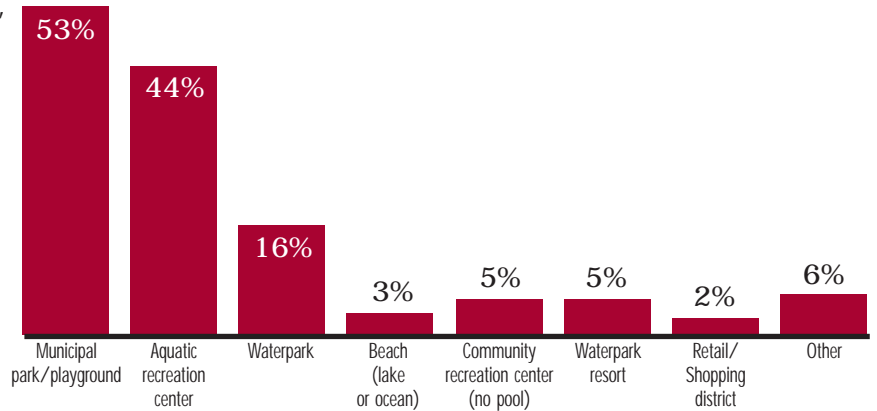


**READING THE SIGNS**

Most respondents' spraypads are at a park, but they can be found just about anywhere. (Respondents were asked to mark all answers that apply.)

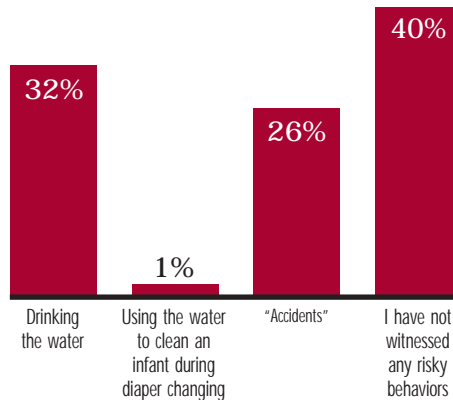

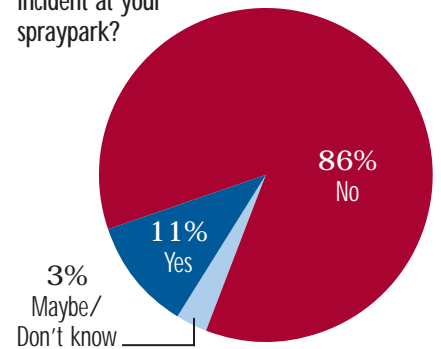

When it comes to unsafe conduct on the part of spraypark patrons, operators have seen it all. (Respondents were asked to mark all answers that apply.)

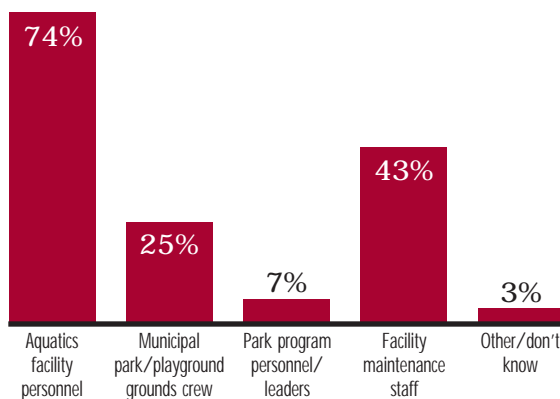


Are you aware of an RWI incident at your spraypark?
